PRO: The Cowboys traded for Bené Benwikere before the start of the 2017 regular season in order to bolster a secondary that saw an influx of youth in the offseason. A fourth-year player, Benwikere was originally drafted by Carolina in the fifth round (148th overall) of the 2014 NFL Draft. He brings 27 games of NFL experience to the Cowboys defensive backfield, and has career totals of 109 tackles, two interceptions, 21 pass breakups, three fumble recoveries and one sack. After playing two-plus seasons with the Panthers, Benwikere was waived on Oct. 7, 2016 and acquired by Miami. He was inactive for three games and then waived by the Dolphins before signing to Miami's practice squad. Benwikere signed with Cincinnati in the 2017 offseason and spent the entire training camp with the Bengals. His zone coverage skills and experience should give him a chance to contribute immediately in the Dallas secondary.

2017 (Cincinnati):

- Signed with Cincinnati as a free agent and spent the entire offseason and training camp with the Bengals before being traded to Dallas.

2016 (Carolina/Miami):

- Played in four games for Carolina, totaling 10 tackles, one interception and four pass breakups.
- Was released on Oct. 7 and acquired off waivers by the Dolphins, where he was a healthy scratch for three games before being released and added to Miami's practice squad for the remainder of the season.
- Intercepted a Trevor Siemian pass in third quarter at Denver (9/8).
- Recorded four tackles and a pass defended against San Francisco (9/18).
- Tallied four tackles and two passes defended at Atlanta (10/2).

2015 (Carolina):

- Started four-of-13 games played for the Panthers and registered career-bests in tackles (61), sacks (one) and passes defended (10) despite missing three games towards the end of the season with a leg injury.
- Recorded eight tackles and two pass breakups in the season opener at Jacksonville (9/13).
- Registered six tackles and a season-best three passes defended against Green Bay (11/8).
- Made five tackles and recorded his lone-career sack, taking down Kirk Cousins and forcing a fumble, which he recovered, against Washington (11/22).
- Was placed on Reserve/Injured (leg) for the final three games of the regular season, forcing him to miss the Panthers postseason Super Bowl run.

2014 (Carolina):

- Finished his rookie season with 38 tackles, two fumble recoveries, seven pass breakups and an interception, despite missing six games with an ankle injury.
- Recorded five tackles, one pass breakup and recovered a fumble in the season opener at Tampa Bay (9/7).
- Returned to the field after missing six games due to an ankle injury and made three tackles and a pass breakup at Minnesota (11/30).
- Had his lone interception of the year the following week at New Orleans (12/7) to go along with six tackles.
- Started both postseason games for the Panthers, recording three tackles and a pass defended.

COLLEGE:

- Played in 47 games with 30 starts at San Jose State, finishing his career tied for first in school history with 14 interceptions as a two-time All-Conference selection at cornerback with 214 tackles, 22 pass breakups and three forced fumbles on his career resume.
- First-team All-Mountain West Conference choice as a senior in 2013, starting 11 games and pacing the Spartans with five interceptions and 11 passes defended.
- First-team All-Western Athletic Conference selection as a junior in 2012, finishing first in the conference and tied for second in the nation with seven interceptions to go along with four passes defended and 67 tackles.
- Played in 10 games with two starts as a sophomore in 2011, notching 18 tackles, one interception and three passes defended.
- As a freshman in 2010, played in 13 games with nine starts and compiled 74 tackles, one interception, four passes defended and two forced fumbles.

PERSONAL:

- Attended Serra High School in Gardena, Calif., where he finished first-team all-state and was credited with 65 tackles, five pass break-ups and five interceptions as a senior in 2009.
- Three-sport letterwinner played basketball and was a sprinter and jumper in track and field.

PRO: The Dallas Cowboys brought back veteran linebacker Justin Durant to infuse some leadership and add depth at the second level of their defense in 2017. The Cowboys originally landed Justin Durant through free agency in 2013. Durant, an 11th-year pro, first came to Dallas after starting 68 of his 79 career games, playing in both Jacksonville (2007-10) and Detroit (2011-12). He started six of the 10 games he played in 2013, missing five games with a hamstring injury that landed him on Reserve/Injured, and tallied 30 tackles. He was named a team captain for Dallas in 2014 but was injured and only played in six games, making 59 tackles and four tackles for loss. Durant signed with Atlanta in 2015, and was a solid presence in their defense, playing in 13 games and tallying 82 tackles. He returned to Dallas in 2016 and put up good numbers on defense, posting 54 tackles, six pressures and a sack. A former second round draft pick (48th overall) by Jacksonville in 2007, Durant has started 92-of-121 games played and has recorded 809 tackles, 4.5 sacks, 32 tackles for loss, 23 pass breakups and three interceptions over his career.

2016 (Dallas):

- Played in 13 games for the Cowboys, tallying 54 tackles, six pressures, one sack and a tackle for loss.
- In his return to the Cowboys, was third on the defense with eight stops against the N.Y. Giants (9/11).
- Finished third on the defense with nine tackles with a pair of hurries at Green Bay (10/16).
- Topped 800 career tackles, finishing with three along with a pressure and a breakup against Baltimore (11/20).
- Logged one tackle in the playoff game against Green Bay (1/15/17).

2015 (Atlanta):

- Played in 13 games and started 12, tallying 77 tackles, three pass breakups and three tackles for loss for the Falcons.
- Recorded eight tackles and forced a fumble in the season-opening win over Philadelphia (9/14), then racked up a season-high 10 tackles with a pass breakup at the N.Y. Giants (9/21).
- Picked up nine tackles against Dallas in Week 3 (9/27).
- Recorded eight tackles in back-to-back weeks at Carolina (12/13) and at Jacksonville (12/20).
- Finished with five tackles in the season finale against New Orleans (1/3/16).

2014 (Dallas):

- Finished sixth on the team with 59 tackles, but only appeared in six games before being placed on Reserve/Injured with an elbow injury.
- Finished second on the defense with 11 tackles along with a quarterback hurry and a breakup against San Francisco (9/7).
- Led the team with nine tackles, an interception, a forced fumble and two pass breakups at New Orleans (9/28).
- Posted a team-high 11 tackles, a tackle for loss, a quarterback hurry and a pass deflection at Seattle (10/12).
- Tied the team lead with eight tackles along with a team-high three stops for losses before injuring his arm in the second half against Washington (10/27).

2013 (Dallas):

- Started six of the 10 games he played in his first year in Dallas and posted 30 tackles, two for losses, two pressures, a breakup, one forced fumble and a fumble recovery.
- Made his Cowboys debut in the season-opening win against the N.Y. Giants (9/8) and finished with three stops.
- Posted six tackles and forced a fumble that was recovered by Sean Lee as a part of a defense that held St. Louis (9/22) to 18 first half yards.
- Had one tackle and recovered a fumble for a return of five yards in his return to Detroit (10/27).
- Tallied seven tackles, one for a loss and a breakup before an injured hamstring sidelined him in the third quarter at New Orleans (11/10).
- Returned to action after missing three games (hamstring) and tallied two tackles, one for a loss, before re-injuring his hamstring in the second quarter against Green Bay (12/15). Did not return and landed on Reserve/Injured two days later.

2012 (Detroit):

- Started 14-of-16 games and was second on the defense with 103 tackles to go with a half sack, seven tackles for losses and three breakups.
- In the home-opening win over St. Louis (9/9), led the team with a season-best 12 tackles, one for a loss.
- Was third on the squad at San Francisco (9/16) with seven stops before posting four solo stops at Tennessee (9/23).
- Led the Lions for the second time with eight tackles, one for a loss, in the overtime win at Philadelphia (10/14).
- Second on the team with seven tackles while notching his half sack and a pass breakup at Chicago (10/22).
- Had seven tackles (second on the team) against Seattle (10/28) before leading the unit for consecutive games with seven tackles against Jacksonville (11/4) and nine at Minnesota (11/11).
- On Thanksgiving Day against Houston (11/22), posted eight stops, one for a loss, and a deflection.

2011 (Detroit):

- Started 12 of the 13 games he played, missing three games with a concussion, and finished with 68 tackles, one sack, a forced fumble and a pass breakup.
- Part of a defense that gave up 56 rushing yards - a season-low road rushing total - at Tampa Bay (9/11).
- In the home opener against Kansas City (9/18), led the defense with 11 tackles.
- Added six tackles in Detroit's overtime win at Minnesota (9/25).
- Was inactive with a concussion at Dallas (10/2), against Chicago (10/10) and against San Francisco (10/16).
- Returned to the starting lineup against Atlanta (10/23) and notched four tackles and a pass breakup.
- At Denver (10/30) had two tackles while limiting the Broncos to just 117 net passing yards.
- Led the defense with seven tackles, with one for a loss, at Chicago (11/30).
- Posted his first sack of the season to go with three tackles against Green Bay (11/24).
- Forced a fumble and tallied seven stops at Oakland (12/18).

- Added his second sack of the season with a team-best 11 tackles against San Diego (12/24).
- In the season-finale at Green Bay (1/1/12), led the defense with nine stops.
- In a wild card game at New Orleans (1/7/12), finished with nine tackles.

2010 (Jacksonville):

- Started nine of the 10 games he played, missing six with ankle and groin injuries, and finished the season third on the defense with 99 tackles along with five tackles for losses, three breakups and a fumble recovery.
- Tied for the team-high with 11 tackles, with one for a loss, in the opener against Denver (9/12) before posting three tackles, one for a loss, in 11 plays at San Diego (9/19).
- Sprained his ankle at the Chargers and missed the next three games but returned against Tennessee (10/18) with 13 tackles.
- Recovered a fumble to help the Jaguars to the win against Houston (11/14).
- Had his fifth double-digit tackle game of the season with 10 tackles against Cleveland (11/21).
- Suffered a groin injury after posting nine tackles against Oakland (12/12) and was inactive for the remaining three games of the season.

2009 (Jacksonville):

- Moved from outside linebacker to the middle and started a then career-high 13 games, missing three starts due to injury and finished second on the club with 135 tackles, posting double-digit tackle figures five times.
- Added one sack, an interception, two tackles for losses, three pressures and a forced fumble.
- Led the team in the season opener at Indianapolis (9/13) with 14 tackles, then bettered that total the next week with a team-high 15 stops with a forced fumble against Arizona (9/20).
- Posted a team-best 10 tackles at Houston (9/27) before finishing the contest against Tennessee (10/4) with nine stops.
- Was inactive at Seattle (10/11) and against St. Louis (10/18) with a hip injury but returned at Tennessee with a career-best 17 tackles, playing all 67 snaps.
- Had consecutive nine-tackle games against Kansas City (11/8) and at the N.Y. Jets (11/15) but was inactive against Buffalo (11/22) after suffering a concussion in the Jets game.
- Played at San Francisco (11/29) and tallied eight tackles before adding eight tackles, a sack, an interception and two pressures against Houston (12/6) to earn AFC Defensive Player of the Week.
- Surpassed 100 tackles for the second straight season after racking up 13 stops against Miami (12/13) then finished the season with seven-tackle games at New England (12/27) and at Cleveland (1/3/10).

2008 (Jacksonville):

- Started 12-of-14 games played and placed third on the team with 113 tackles. Led the team with seven tackles for lost yardage along with six passes defended and a pressure. Added three special teams stops.
- Named to the *USA Today* All-Joe Team.
- Posted eight stops in the opener at Tennessee (9/7).
- Injured his groin in a start against Buffalo (9/14) and missed games at Indianapolis (9/21) and against Houston (9/28).
- Returned to the field against Pittsburgh (10/5) and notched 10 stops and a pass breakup.
- Started at Denver (10/12) to finish with six tackles, one for a loss, and a breakup.
- Had 11 tackles in a start against Cleveland (10/26) then played all snaps with 12 tackles at Detroit (11/9).
- Posted nine tackles and two special teams stops against Tennessee (11/16) before leading the team with two tackles for losses against Minnesota (11/23).
- Added six tackles and a pressure against Green Bay (12/14) before racking up 10 tackles and a breakup against Indianapolis (12/18).
- Played the entire game and tallied a season-best 14 tackles in the finale at Baltimore (12/28).

2007 (Jacksonville):

- After being selected in the second round (48th overall) in the NFL Draft, started eight of the 13 games he played and recorded 71 tackles, three stops for losses, one sack, and an interception.
- Led the team in two postseason starts with 31 tackles.
- Made his NFL debut as a reserve in the opener against Tennessee (9/9) and notched a pair of special teams tackles.
- Earned his first career start against Atlanta (9/16) and had his first six defensive stops.
- Took over as the full-time starter against Buffalo (11/25) when Mike Peterson suffered a season-ending injury prior to the game and intercepted his first career pass while leading the team with 11 tackles.
- Tallied 11 tackles at Indianapolis (12/2) before posting a then career-best 13 stops at Pittsburgh (12/16).
- Had his first career sack, along with a team-best 12 tackles against Oakland (12/23).
- Started a wild card playoff game at Pittsburgh (1/5/08) and led the team with 17 tackles - second in team playoff history.
- In the AFC Divisional Playoff Game at New England (1/12/08) finished second on the defense with 14 stops.

COLLEGE:

- Became the first student/athlete in Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference history to earn MEAC Defensive Player of the Year honors three times.
- Started 39 of the 43 games he played at middle linebacker for Hampton and left second in school history with 353 tackles while adding 10.0 sacks, three fumble recoveries and four interceptions.
