- Tops in the NFL in rushing yards (1,631) and attempts (322), third with 15 touchdowns and third in scoring (96 points) in 2016.
- Became fifth rookie since 1970 merger to lead NFL in rushing, (Earl Campbell, George Rogers, Eric Dickerson and Edgerrin James).
- Second in the NFL - third by a rookie in league history, with 1,994 total scrimmage yards.
- Earned his first Pro Bowl selection and was named All-Pro first-team in 2016.
- Along with Dak Prescott, they were the first rookie duo with at least 3,500 passing yards and at least 1,500 rushing yards. Also first pair in NFL history with 20-plus passing touchdowns and 15-plus rushing.
- Became the club's all-time leading rookie rusher in the first quarter against Baltimore (11/20/16).
- Earned NFC Rookie of the Month (October, 2016).
- His 1,631 yards are third all-time among NFL rookies and tops among Dallas rookies:
